**LEVELS:**

USDF Introductory Level through Grand Prix, including GAIG/USDF Qualifying Classes.

**AWARDS:**

Six ribbons in each class. USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal for highest scoring AA USDF member over 58% in Class 213. Championship ribbon and cooler awarded for highest scored test each day.

## ENTRIES

- Introductory Level: \$35 per class
- Training through Fourth Level: \$40 per class, GAIG/USDF Qualifying add \$10
- FEI Prix St. Georges through Grand Prix: \$50 per class, GAIG/USDF Qualifying add \$10
- Non-competing horse (no drug fee required): \$50
- USEF Drug fee per horse: \$12
- Office fee per horse/rider combination: \$20
- USEF non-member fee (\$20) and/or discipline fee (\$5) for non-Jrs.—rider, owner, trainer
- USDF non-member fee (\$20)--rider, owner
- Non-negotiable check: \$25

Checks payable to: Stockade Polo & Saddle Club, Inc. and mailed to show secretary. Include copies of 2008 USEF and USDF membership info for rider, owner, trainer and horse. Horses, riders and owners competing ONLY in Introductory Level are exempt from membership requirements. Please include negative Coggins test within 12 months of show. Post entries (including class changes) will be accepted if schedule permits, with a post-entry fee of \$10 per class. For cancellations made by the closing date, entries will be refunded in full, less \$20 office fee. All refunds will be mailed after the show. **Entry fees and stall assignments are non-transferable and non-refundable after the closing date.** Management may refuse any entry whose account is not in good standing by the start of the competition.

## TIMES:

Times will be posted online at [www.stockadepolo.com](http://www.stockadepolo.com) approximately one week before the show. Official times will be posted at the show and included in the show program.

## STABLING:

Temporary stabling, with doors, is available in shed-row configuration: \$140 per stall. Stalls available from noon Friday, August 7 through 7:00 PM Sunday, August 9. Shavings available for purchase on-site. A \$50 stall cleaning deposit will be charged--please include a separate check. Stall deposit will be destroyed if stall is left stripped when horse departs. Stabling fees may not be split between entries. Tack stalls available.

## DIRECTIONS:

Stockade Polo & Saddle Club, Inc. is located on Route 147 (Sacandaga Road) in Glenville, NY with access from the Beukendaal Firehouse driveway. **From I-87/Northway (points north):** I-87 Exit 12 (Malta) to Rte 67 west. Take Rte 67 west to Rte 147/Sacandaga Rd (traffic light, Stewart's, church at intersection). Turn left (south) onto Rte 147. Show is approximately 9 miles from Route 67, on the right. Look for blinking light, Spring Road on left, Beukendaal Firehouse on the right. Turn into the firehouse parking lot and follow the driveway behind the firehouse to the show grounds. **From I-90/Route 890 (points east):** Thruway (I-90) Exit 25 to Rte 890 heading west. Rte 890 will cross the Mohawk River, ending at Route 5. Cross Route 5 (*do not turn*) and exit Rte 890 straight onto Vley Road. Continue on Vley Road to Route 147 access on the right, immediately after underpass. Turn right (north) onto Route 147, over bridge (passing back over Vley Road). Immediately after bridge turn left into the Beukendaal Firehouse parking lot and follow the driveway behind the firehouse to the show grounds. **From I-88 (points west):** Rte I-88 east to its end. Thruway (I-90) west to Exit 26. Go straight off exit ramp onto Rte 890 west and follow directions as above.

## FOOTING:

Two 20m x 60m (standard) competition arenas with sand footing. Introductory and Training Level Test 1 may be run in a small arena (20m x 40m). Ample warm-up and longeing areas on sand or grass. Polo field also available for riding, but not longeing.

## ENTERTAINMENT:

Food will be available on the grounds throughout the competition.

Appropriate ASTM/SEI helmets are strongly suggested for all riders. Riders who choose not to wear protective helmets do so at their own risk.

All dogs must be leashed or confined while on the show grounds.

Management reserves the right to combine, divide or cancel any classes as entries warrant.

**Note:** Minors who do not have a valid drivers license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid drivers license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s) and/or Trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or Trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Rule 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. BOD 1/16/06 Effective 12/01/05.

**ATTENTION COMPETITORS**

Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, United States Equestrian Federation) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition.

The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
